The application must include:

- Title of the paper
- Names of all the authors
- Abstract in English (or Czech plus English) in 100-300 words
- Concise, professional bio note of authors, maximum 200 words per author
- Photograph of authors in JPEG, minimal resolution 300 dpi

The final version of the paper should respect this structure:

- Title of the paper (presentation)
- Names and surnames of the authors
- Name of the organisation/company, address, country, email addresses
- Paper annotation/abstract
- Keywords
- The text of the paper
- References used

All documents listed above should be provided electronically as a PDF or Word DOC, PowerPoint 2003 (or higher), each presentation with a maximum of 30 slides, in English.
