The need for quick reactions connected with new technologies like UAS or hypersonic opens top-level discussions. These new technologies require sophisticated research and development at the tactical, operational and strategic levels. - Tactics, techniques and procedures through the prism of new threats (C-UAS, Swarms, Hypersonic)
